Registration

Registration has gone very smooth for the last couple of years and we will continue the same format. Paperwork can be found under the News page tab on the Tally Ho Farm website and printed from the website, please go to www.tallyhofarm.com. All students must have a Registration Form, Riding Liability Release and Barn Rule form signed and submitted by the end of August in order to continue in the lesson program. Everyone who boards a horse must also sign and submit a new Boarding Agreement in order to continue boarding the horse at Tally Ho Farm. We encourage you to read all of these documents carefully before signing and turning them in because they are the foundation of our relationship with you. Everyone has received the charge for registration on their invoice this month. Now all you have to do is stop by the barn during open registration hours, listed below and turn in the paper work. We have pre-ordered the shirts this year and if you come by during these open hours you will get your shirt when the paper work is turned in. We will also have a choice of Tally Ho Farm duffle bags or water bottles to select from. As a bonus to those who choose to receive their invoice by email we have decals without names to give away or we will have an order list for decals with the child's name at the bottom. Extra decals can also be ordered for \$10 each with or without the child's name at the bottom. Registration hours have been extended to make it more convenient for all the parents to come by when they drop their kid for the lesson.

Students enrolling in PE at Tally Ho Farm will need to pickup and fill out a PE agreement form from Tally Ho Farm. This form explains how each student will record their hours for grades, what is required of each student to pass and the fee charged by Tally Ho to process and record your grade with your school every three weeks.

Barn Appearance

Last year we asked that saddle pads be removed from saddle racks and outside of the stalls because we wanted the appearance of the barn to be one of neatness and orderliness. It also allowed us to better control pests that were making themselves at home in the discarded saddle pads left lying on the floors. Since that time we started noticing multiple halters being hung on the outside of the stalls and hanging racks on stall doors. It has become apparent that not only does this appear unsightly but also is a safety concern to us. Since the horse can
