

Clinic Information

This year the clinic will be held from June 7th – June 11th and from June 14th -18th. Both a morning session and an afternoon session will be held with a limited number of students in each session. There will be **NO WEEKLY LESSONS**, by any of the instructors the two weeks of Clinic. The morning sessions will be from 7:30am-12pm and the afternoon will be from 2pm-6:30pm. Each session will take 25 riders of all levels and will be divided into 4 appropriate levels for both riding lessons and ground lessons. The cost for each session will be \$375.

Clinic time will be divided into a 1 ½ hour riding lesson and a two plus hour ground lesson. This year we have decided to divide the students into 4 smaller groups. We will ride two groups at a time and all the students will ride in the indoor riding arenas. This will require less time for water breaks and fewer students will mean more ride time for each student. There will be 5 instructors this year and we feel this is some of the best ground lesson time we get with our riders at Tally Ho farm. Being a good equestrian is so much more than just riding and these clinics offer lessons about horsemanship. We also feel by dividing the ground groups up we will be able to specialize the lesson to the needs of each group level giving the advanced students more of a challenge and not letting the more beginner students miss the basics. We realize to cancel lessons will be an inconvenience to some of the students, but feel the experience and the knowledge offered during clinic time is worth this effort by everyone. Please consider allowing your child to participate in clinic this year.

No student will be listed on the clinic roster until both the form and deposit has been turned into the barn. Please remember this clinic has filled every year! Do not put off signing up if you want to participate. Drop box will be checked daily to make sure proper order of sign up occurs.
